While there are no known cases of COVID-19 in Santee, in an abundance of caution and in consultation with the San Diego County Office of Education, the Santee School District will be closed beginning Monday, March 16th through the end of the regularly scheduled spring break with plans to return on Monday, April 13th.

Santee School District will be offering families three days of emergency care at every school site Monday, March 16th – Wednesday, March 18th. As public service employees, we need all employees to report to work as usual on Monday. If you are ill or you will be the primary care provider for your own children during these three days, due to school closures, please submit your absence using the emergency code “closure emergency” in Aesop. We need to be able to track the number of employees available for Monday, so please submit as soon as possible.

During the time our schools are closed, certain essential positions will continue to work and provide services important to our community and district operations. Your supervisor will speak with you regarding your position and how you will be needed during the two-week period prior to spring break. All employees will be in a paid status during this time period.

As we approach the end of spring break, we will reassess the community health concerns, monitor information from the California Health Department, and determine next steps at that time. Please monitor your email for updates.
