Employee Pay

I've been asked about employee pay again recently, which is understandable based on our need to keep our school sites closed for now. This is the guidance we provided to employees on March 18 and this guidance remains the same today:

All employees will be paid their regular rate of pay during the closure, including full-time/part-time, and our long-term substitutes on assignment as of March 16, 2020.

Essential Employee Document

In my email as an attachment, I've included an essential employee document that you will want with you when you drive to and from work. **This hasn't been an issue for anyone in our district** but we also don't want you caught in an uncomfortable situation if asked about travel to and from home and work someday.

Child Nutrition Services

After today's food service by our nutrition department, Child Nutrition Services has served 13,000 meals.

After spring break, beginning Tuesday, April 14, we will be offering breakfast and lunches at a second pick-up location, PRIDE Academy School. Increasing our participation helps our community and helps us re-cooperate funding to support these daily meals. On a typical school day, our Child Nutrition Services program serves 1,100 breakfasts and 2,800 lunches. We are serving approximately 1,000 breakfasts and 1,000 lunches during our closure.
