## Class Descriptions

### New CalPERS Member

As you begin your new career journey, you'll want to know about your CalPERS benefits and the programs we offer. Class topics include service retirement, pre-retirement death benefits, leaving your employer, and much more.

### Continuing CalPERS Member

When you're midway through your career, you'll want to get a better understanding of your retirement benefits. This class focuses on how your retirement allowance is calculated, purchase of service credit, benefits of having a power of attorney on file and more.

### Planning Your Retirement

Retiring is a significant milestone in your life. As you prepare for retirement, know what steps to take before that important day. Subjects include service credit, retirement formulas and benefit factors, final compensation, retirement calculation, survivor continuance, retirement payment options, health benefits, and much more.

### Completing Your Retirement Application

Once you're ready to retire, you may want assistance with completing your service retirement application. In this class, you will receive step-by-step instructions for filling out your application as well as an explanation of the different retirement options available to you.

  - Choose date, location and time you want to attend and select "Enroll."

  - Verify information entered is correct then select "Next."
  - Review information and select "Submit."
