EIGHTH GRADE SUPPLY WISH LIST

The following is a suggested list of supplies. One of our expectations is for students to be prepared and ready to work when they walk into the classroom.

- Composition book – 8¹/₂ x 6 (approximately 4 for literature)
- Three-ring binder (with dividers)
- Spiral notebook (for Science labs)
- Pencils - #2 standard pencil or mechanical (mechanical should use soft lead)
- Pens – black and blue
- Colored pencils – full set
- Felt pens – full set
- Crayons – 16 pack
- Glue Stick
- Small Individual Stapler
- Paper - 8¹/₂ x 11 lined
- Thesaurus
- Backpack – a rolling backpack is highly recommended as we are unable to supply lockers for the students and the books are heavy and can be cumbersome
- Calculator
- Combination lock for P.E. Please do not bring a key padlock. Master Lock with a dial would be great.
- P.E. clothes – school uniform will be: blue shorts, white t-shirt, athletic shoes and socks (clothes should be at school by Monday, September 8th). School uniforms can be purchased at Al's Sporting Goods on Mission Gorge Road. If you choose not to purchase the clothing, please provide a pair of blue shorts and a white t-shirt.
