Students are encouraged to regularly check grades on PowerGrade using the school website. Any concerns should be addressed ASAP. Additionally, students can always see me before or after school to discuss grades.

Homework/Classwork

Homework will only exist as an extension of the students' daily class work. While students have the opportunity to complete their work in class, efforts outside of school will be required if the class work is not finished. Going above and beyond is always encouraged.

Late Work/ Absences

Any class work checks or homework assignments turned in late will receive an F grade and will NOT be accepted late. Larger assignments/projects turned in late will be docked 10% per day it is late (5 days late will only receive 50% of the **earned** grade). **After 5 days late, assignments will receive an F grade!**

Students with excused absences will be given the same number of missed days to make up missed assignments (excluding projects and tests; these are due upon the date of return) before these assignments become late. Students are required to check our website for assignments, PowerGrade for posted grades, and will always have opportunities in class to ask for help.
