<p>A Outstanding</p>	<p>Student exhibits excitement towards learning, consistently demonstrating a capacity for hard work, advancing the goals of the class through contributions, and modeling persistence and a commitment to excellence. In addition, the student reflects on, and clearly appreciates how his or her personal work ethic affects the quality of the experience of others. He or she ALWAYS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comes to class prepared • Participates in class • Pays attention • Turns in quality classwork/homework in a timely manner • Fills out student planner accurately • Works on tasks until they are completed even when difficulties arise
<p>B Good</p>	<p>Student understands the benefits of a quality work ethic, and generally models preparedness and participation. The student USUALLY:</p> <p>Comes to class prepared</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participates in class • Pays attention • Turns in quality classwork/homework in a timely manner • Fills out student planner accurately • Works on tasks until they are completed even when difficulties arise
<p>C Satisfactory</p>	<p>Student does not generally demonstrate an understanding of the benefits of a quality work effort. The student INCONSISTENTLY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comes to class prepared • Participates in class • Pays attention • Turns in quality classwork/homework in a timely manner • Fills out student planner accurately • Works on tasks until they are completed even when difficulties arise
<p>D Needs Improvement</p>	<p>Student demonstrates a negative regard for quality work and an inability/unwillingness to accept responsibility for personal goals. The student RARELY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comes to class prepared • Participates in class • Pays attention • Turns in quality classwork/homework in a timely manner • Fills out student planner accurately • Works on tasks until they are completed even when difficulties arise
<p>F Unsatisfactory</p>	<p>Student demonstrates a negative regard for quality work and an inability/unwillingness to accept responsibility for personal goals. The student NEVER:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comes to class prepared • Participates in class • Pays attention • Turns in quality classwork/homework in a timely manner • Fills out student planner accurately • Works on tasks until they are completed even when difficulties arise
