The District and CSEA met for negotiations on March 25, 2011 from 8:30am to 3:00pm. Below is a District synopsis of topics discussed and their status:

Article II: Recognition	Tentative Agreement reached.
Article IV: Association Rights	To be continued with CSEA consideration of District Counter-Proposal 3.
Article VI: Employee Rights	To be continued with CSEA consideration of District Counter-Proposal 2.
Article VIII: Procedure for Evaluation	Tentative Agreement reached.
Article IX: Safety	To be continued with CSEA consideration of District Counter-Proposal 1.
Article X: Hours	To be continued with CSEA clarification of initial proposal to District.
