Overview: Strategic Planning Process began in February. Student Well Being Subcommittee set a vision of working toward a one-stop shop. We've been assessing what that would look like and have been in the process of identifying the target group, how we would fund it, and identifying the criteria of the program. We are hoping to be completed by June, 2013.

Survey:

- Almost 10% of our population has responded back to the survey.
- Santee Santas will also be responding to survey as the community comes in to fill out applications for assistance/support.
- More surveys to come... (Sycamore Canyon Special Education Preschool, Santee Santas, etc.)

Ideas:

- Should SSP give out the survey to the parents whose child begins at the SSP (this would only exclude Sycamore Canyon, as they do not have students being transferred to the SSP).
- Translate survey into different languages and give out to the DELAC community
  - Santee Santas will also have EL families, but they most often bring their own translator.
- Finalize a referral form

Criteria of who to include:

- Have criteria in place ahead of time (ex. Non-profit organizations)
- Who wants to play?
- Idea is that by 2017, we will have multiple locations.

Successes, Announcements, and Concerns

- How do we know that "If we build it, they will come?" Virtual list seems important, but an actual individual sitting behind a desk waiting for people... how do we know it'll be necessary?
  - This is a 5-year process... we will continue to seek the need.
    - This is a work-in-progress for a long time while we change, modify, and revamp the process.
- Referral/Service type of program?
- Use current staff (i.e. counselors) or a volunteer (college student, retiree, etc.) to man the center.
- Invite apartment complex managers to a meeting since they know so well the needs of their families.

- Advertise the One-Stop shop as banners like AYSO and baseball advertise.
- Momentum Tutoring – growing!
  - Open House – December 14<sup>th</sup>.
  - CO site – needs to hire more tutors for people who are asking.
- Thanksgiving morning
  - 5K – waddle and trot
    - Proceeds go to Santee Santas and Food Bank
- Congratulations to Alana, our new elected school board member
- Autistic support group information – Marj will send to Meredith so she can distribute to the group.
