1. 2-1-1 Resource center for different needs (prescription drugs, homelessness, food stamps, medical, etc.) – Will be putting our programs into a list and bringing it back to the committee as a draft.
 - a. Online reports by city that show what resources that community asks for
 - b. Criteria of what makes up a 2-1-1 facility
 - c. Who to include/exclude... For-profit companies? Or just non-profit?
 - d. Chula Vista handled approval of facilities through BOE
 - e. Use of facility charge...
 - f. Money could go toward school counseling
 - i. Less grant dependent and more self-sustaining
 - g. Momentum tutoring and other companies are already interested
 - h. Those companies that fit within the districts mission and vision would be approved
 - i. Advocacy groups that fit in the mission/vision
 - j. Clubs? (Girl Scouts, TOPS, etc.?)
 - k. There will be guidelines to follow for acceptance
 - l. How close do we allow people who do not have fingerprints on file?
 - m. Exclusion
 - i. Services should not conflict with services that are already provide by the District
 - ii. Look into the legal implications of each exclusion

 - a. Tracking system so we can record requests
 - b. We could use the data to trace what time of year most requests come in about what services
 - c. Includes a release of information
 - d. Placing form online as a pilot test
3. Fleet and Family Services Colocation at CFH (Our first program for SSD OSS)
 - a. Military organization who supports families through counseling and classes
 - b. Borrowing space at CFH
 - i. Own space off campus
 - c. Ex. How to buy a car... (when you're in the military); What to do when going over seas
 - d. Having a grand opening (Late April or early May)
 - e. Open to public and military
