## School Facilities

The district takes great efforts to ensure that all schools are clean, safe, and functional through proper facilities maintenance and campus supervision. Hill Creek School's original facilities were built in 1973; ongoing maintenance and campus improvements ensure facilities remain up-to-date and provide adequate space for students and staff. District maintenance and site custodial staff ensure that the repairs necessary to keep the school in good condition are completed in a timely manner. A work order process is used by school and district staff to communicate non-routine maintenance requests. Emergency repairs are given the highest priority. During Summer 2010, installation of solar panels was completed. Beginning Summer 2011, campus modernization will take place, which will include classroom renovation, playground improvements, and the building of a new Junior High building.
