Dear Parents:

Would you like to become better informed with regard to school funding and play a role in school expenditure decisions? The School Site Council is a very important entity that provides valuable parent input as we make important budgetary decisions. PRIDE Academy receives funds from the State of California under the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) and from the Federal Government under Title 1. The School Site Council approves expenditures for Title 1 and may be consulted periodically for the use of LCFF funds.

In order to continue our eligibility for these funds we must meet certain requirements. We must establish a Single Site Plan for School Improvement and maintain an active School Site Council. This council is made up of elected representatives comprised of staff members and parent or community members. The council monitors achievement goals, provides guidance with regard to LCFF and approves expenditures of Title 1 monies. The council meets on Mondays from 2:30-3:00 pm, for a total of seven months during the school year.
