

EMERGENCY PROTOCOLS

In partnership with local emergency service providers, Santee School District has created emergency operation plans to ensure the safety and security of our schools. During an emergency, the district will communicate with families as quickly and frequently as possible. Please review the protocols below.



How will I be notified?

Please do not call the school - we need to keep our lines of communication open with first responders.

You will receive a recorded phone call, email, text message, and/or push notification from the district app, depending on the preferences you set up in Powerschool.



Can I pick up my child?

Do not visit the school. Children will not be dismissed until district officials and/or law enforcement have declared the situation to be safe. If early dismissal is deemed necessary, instructions will be sent via phone and an email.



How do I update my contact information?

Contact information is pulled from PowerSchool. If you need to update primary and emergency contact information, please contact your school office.



Opt-in for emergency texts.

Text YES to 67587 to receive text updates during an emergency. Double check that the cell phone number you opt in from is listed in your Powerschool account. If it needs to be updated, please contact your school's office.
